

## Required Entry Assessments

Effective July 1, 2019: The Virginia Department of Education no longer mandates entry assessments for state-approved initial teacher licensure programs. However, to comply with state and national accreditation requirements, applicants must submit test scores on one of the following categories. Applicants failing to meet the guidelines below may be required to take additional tests as a condition of their admission to the program.
